## KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Date: February 11, 2010

Location: Blessed Trinity Community Center

Time: 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Who attends: One custodial **parent or guardian *must attend***, but both are welcome

### Required Paperwork (due at time of registration):

- Birth certificate issued by the state of birth
- Baptismal certificate (if Catholic)
- Child's Social Security Card
- Immunization form #680 issued by the Fla. Dept. of Health
- Physical examination form Fla. Dept. of Health #3040 from child's physician

Students entering Florida schools from another state with immunization and physical forms from that state must take those forms to the Health Department for review and issuance of Forms HRS 680 and HRS 3040, respectively.

- Registration fee, \$490 per student.
- Recent tax return if registering as a Stewardship family (see below)
- Kindergarten screening test permission letter (will be signed at time of registration)
- Parent rating form (filled out at time of registration)

### Helpful information:

Be prepared to meet with Fr. Pat for approximately 10-15 minutes. At this time you will sign either a **Stewardship\* Verification** card OR a **Full Cost of Education\*\*** card.

\* Families who are *registered with the parish, are participating in the Stewardship Way of Life, and are living up to their pledge with the Church via using their envelopes at the weekend Mass*, may avail themselves of the Catholic educational ministry of the Church at no cost. Refer to [www.blessedtrinity.org/stewardship](http://www.blessedtrinity.org/stewardship) for information regarding Stewardship. **If you are planning to register as a Stewardship family, you must bring your most recent tax return and W-2(s) with you to registration in order for Fr. Pat to sign your Stewardship Verification card.** New Stewardship families will be required to attend "Stewardship 101," a class designed to inform parishioners on all aspects of the Stewardship Way of Life.

\*\* Non-Stewardship families will pay the full cost of education, \$5200 per student per year. Full cost payments may be broken down into 10 monthly payments, due by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month, August through May. Payments will be processed through a billing company.

All prospective kindergarteners are screened for kindergarten readiness. Angels-in-Arms students will be tested during their school day. Non-Angels students will be tested on a Saturday. A date and time will be mailed to you. Once we have established that we are able to adequately meet the needs of your child, you will receive an acceptance letter for entrance into the kindergarten program. In the event we do not have enough kindergarten openings to accommodate all applicants, we will compile a waiting list based on our admissions policy, [www.btschool.org/admissions](http://www.btschool.org/admissions).
