The Stewardship Way of Life is promoted and lived out at Blessed Trinity Parish. Those committed to the Stewardship Way of Life are strong active Catholics who have pledged **to participate at one of the weekend Masses**, are involved in one or more ministries of the parish and make a weekly offering (10% of your gross household income to the church at Mass).

Those families who fully embrace the Stewardship Way of Life, according to the above definition, and who are 100% current in their commitment to the church, do not pay tuition. They are responsible for the fees listed above and their tithe to the church.

Students enrolled in extended care, athletics, or other after school activities will be assessed additional fees.

Scholarships

Blessed Trinity participates in several scholarships, **Step Up for Students FES- UA** (formerly Gardiner /McKay Scholarship) for students with Unique Abilities; **Step Up for Students, Family Empowerment, and AAA**, which are all income-based. **However, regardless of household income, all K-12* students, residents of Florida are eligible.**

Step Up for Students FES- UA (formerly Gardiner /McKay Scholarship) allows parents to personalize the education of their children with unique abilities by directing money toward a combination of programs and approved providers. These include schools, therapists, specialists, curriculum, technology – even a college savings account. This program provides scholarships for eligible students with disabilities to attend an eligible private school of their choice. **While Blessed Trinity strives to accommodate the needs of our students, we may not be able to fulfill all FES- UA student’s special needs.** If you would like further information about this scholarship, please contact Liza D’Ambrosio in the school office at Ldambrosio@btschool.org

Step Up for Students, Family Empowerment and AAA are income-based scholarships. The scholarships are funded by Florida corporate taxes. Corporations may redirect taxes they pay to the state of Florida to the Step Up for Student or AAA Scholarship. In return, they receive tax credit. To qualify for the Step Up or AAA scholarship, a child entering kindergarten must be 5 on or before Sept. 1.
